The Official Organization Rules of the Event

“Santa’s Race” – Second Edition

December 17, between 16.00 h and 18.00 h, Piața Unirii,

Cluj-Napoca

This Competition is addressed to everyone who has a passion about sports, who wants to develop a healthy lifestyle, but also to those who are concerned about our less lucky fellows.

Category: Open Race

Distance: approximately 3 km

Participation fee: 30 RON

Everyone over the age of 14 can participate in this event.

SECTION 1. THE ORGANIZERS AND THE OFFICIAL RULES OF THE COMPETITION

“Santa’s Race” – Second Edition, named from now on “The Competition” is organized by the Inceptis Movens Association and it is a sports event with charitable purposes.

The Competition is organized in order to provide scholarships for children from the rural areas, with reduced financial possibilities, with the help of which they will continue their studies. The children will be selected with the help of the program “I want to be in the 9th grade” (put in motion by the World Vision Romania Foundation)

All the funds resulted from the Competition, will be donated exclusively to the children selected in the program “I want to be in the 9th grade”.

The participants to the Competition are required to respect the Terms and Conditions of the present Rules of the Competition (named from now on “The Official Rules”).

The Official Rules is compiled and will be made public according to the current legislation in Romania, being available freely for any interested party on the website <http://inceptismovens.com> and at the designated site of the Competition, both in Romanian and English.

By participating in this Competition, the participants agree to respect and comply with all the mentions, terms and conditions in the Official Rules and of the legislation currently enforceable and sign the statutory declaration (according to case – adult or parent/legal guardian) that can be found on the Organizer's website – <http://inceptismovens.com> – or when picking up the kit at the validation of the registration.

The competitors will show fair play whenever necessary and they will protect themselves and each other and act accordingly in order to get to the finish line without any issues.

SECTION 2. THE PERIOD AND AREA OF THE COMPETITION

2.1. THE DATE AND THE PLACE OF THE COMPETITION:

The competition will take place Saturday, December 17, 2016. The start will be at 1700h.

The Start and Finish line will be marked accordingly, on the Eroilor Boulevard in Cluj-Napoca.

SECTION 3. THE MECHANISM OF THE COMPETITION

3.1. THE PARTICIPANTS AND THE EVOLUTION OF THE COMPETITION

This Competition is addressed to everyone who has a passion about sports, who wants to develop a healthy lifestyle, but also to those who are concerned about our less lucky fellows.

The Competition consists of a 3 km race both for teenagers over 14 and adults.

3.2. THE ROUTE OF THE COMPETITION:

The route of the Competition is the following:

Eroilor Boulevard – Baba Novac Street – M. Kogălnieanu Street – Universității – I.C. Brătianu Street – Baba Novac Street – Eroilor Boulevard..

The route will be properly flagged both by marks and volunteers.

The volunteers will be responsible for the competitors' complying with the Official Rules and following of the designated route, being positioned in different areas.

3.3 REGISTRATION

The online registration is possible by filling in the form at <http://inceptismovens.com>. The registration must be followed by the payment of the participation fee in order to be validated by the organizers.

The registration can also be made when picking up the kits, at the place of the Competition, which is Piața Unirii, where we will have a special area, flagged as „Santa’s Race”, in the following days:

3.4. PARTICIPATION FEE

All the participants will pay a 30 RON fee, but we also encourage donations besides this amount. The money collected both from the participation tax and donations will be redirected towards the beneficiaries of this project.

We encourage everyone to donate in order to be able to help the children selected in the program “I want to be in the 9th grade” (put in motion by the World Vision Romania Foundation) with scholarships, whether they participate or not to the race.

The payment can be made:

2. Via bank transfer / deposit in the account RO72BTRLRONCRT0323931801, opened at Banca Transilvania. The fee can be paid through this payment option at the latest on Thursday, 15 December 2016, 14.00h.

In the description the participant must mention his/her name, eg. “Popescu Virgil – participation fee for “Santa’s Race” – second edition”. The bank fees will be paid by the participant, according to the fees of the bank that he is a client of.

3.5. THE STATUTORY DECLARATION

All the adult competitors will write a statutory declaration that they are medically able to participate in the Competition.

For competitors under the age of 18, one of their parents/legal guardians will write a statutory declaration in which they will declare that the participant is medically able to participate in the Competition.

3.6. EQUIPMENT AND COMPETITION CONDITIONS. KITS. DRESS CODE

Dress code: Red/Christmas Characters

The competitors will participate in the Competition with their own equipment.

We recommend the competitors wear running equipment adequate to the meteorological conditions on the date of the Competition (including adequate footwear), preferably red or dressed as characters typical for Christmas. We will give a prize to the most original character/group of Christmas characters.

The kits will be provided by the organizers and they will be given to the participants after the payment of the fee and the filling of the statutory declarations or their turning in in the case of underage participants.

The kits will be provided in the following days:

Thursday, December 15. 2016, 15.00h to 19.00h – Turnul Croitorilor

The contest numbers (which will be in the kits) will be placed on the chest or abdomen of every competitor, without being obstructed.

3.7. EVENT START. RACE START AND TIME LIMITS.

The event will begin at 16.00h in Piața Unirii with the Festivity of the Children for which we run, music, fun and race preparations.

The start of the race will be at 17.00h. There will be a short warm-up 10 minutes earlier, under the guidance of T GYM trainers.

The time limit is 30 minutes.

All the finalists of the Competition, no matter what their time is, will receive a medal.

SECTION 4. THE FESTIVITY OF THE CHILDREN FROM THE PROJECT “I WANT TO BE IN THE 9TH GRADE”. PRIZE-AWARDING FESTIVITY.

- 4.1. The children for whom we run, the children selected in the “I want to be in the 9th grade” program will perform in a festivity as a thank you for the efforts of the participants and supporters.
- 4.2. The competitors that will finish the race on the first three places, both in men and women, will receive prizes.
- 4.3. We will give a prize to the most original Christmas character / group of Christmas characters.

SECTION 5. ADMINISTRATIVE CONDITIONS.

5.1. ADMINISTRATIVE CONDITIONS (DURING THE RACE)

The event is organized by the Inceptis Movens Association, which implements the event and provides the volunteers necessary for the Competition. During the Competition, the participants cannot leave the running route and cannot change it by shortening it or choosing alternative routes. The participants that give the Competition up during the race are asked to announce the organizers. The competition will have medical assistance provided in case of injuries, and the medical team will be near the start/finish line.

5.2. ADMINISTRATIVE CONDITIONS (GENERAL)

The competitors are forbidden to dispose of any left-overs or trash in the area of the Competition or else they will be disqualified. They will use the existing trash cans.

The participation of anyone who has alcoholic beverages or drugs in their possession or is under the influence of said substances or has weapons of any kind or explosive or incendiary materials or tear gas or paralyzing substances or tasters or any other objects that can be used for violent or turbulent actions in their possession is strictly forbidden. Anyone who does not comply to these regulations will be removed from the area of the event by the organizers, and, if necessary, with the help of local police.

The organizers maintain their right to modify the current Official Rules until the date of the Competition, with the obligation of announcing any modification on the website and at the site of the competition.
